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*Ashton Manor is located in lovely surroundings just outside of the historic market town of Farnham, which enjoys good public transport links to most parts of the country. The home is within easy walking distance of the village of Wrecclesham, which includes a post office, hairdressers, public houses and numerous shops. St Peter's Church lies adjacent to the property. It is a distinguished Grade Two property set in the beautiful landscaped gardens and was the one time home of the Bishop of Winchester.*

*Ashton Manor is an exclusive, privately owned nursing home, offering a distinctive environment for the personal care and attention for elderly and requiring specialised dementia care. The Home is registered to care for people over the age of sixty, who need nursing care in order to lead their lives comfortably in a warm, homely and caring atmosphere.*

*Ashton Manor Nursing Home is part of Beritaz Care, a small family owned group with extensive experience and reputation in providing quality care for the elderly. We believe the success of the operation depends on providing a level of care that we will expect for our own elderly relatives. Our aim is to provide Care in a friendly, relaxed yet professional environment.*

*We welcome residents who require either short term care, rehabilitation, or long term permanent care or palliative care.*

*Accommodation is offered in both single and shared bedrooms, each of which has a nurse call system, all with bright and attractive outlooks and most with their own facilities. We welcome prospective residents bringing their own familiar and treasured items into the Home to decorate their rooms so that they may settle comfortably.*



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*We offer planned nursing care that is based on taking account of our residents' individual needs and their abilities, and offering the care necessary to achieve an optimal quality of life of their choice. We have a variety of specialist equipment including hoists and pressure relieving beds to cater for every care needs.*

*The Staff are carefully selected and well trained. They endeavour to help residents plan their day to undertake a variety of activities of their choice. A comprehensive and varied activities programme, designed to stimulate the need of all our residents is arranged by our in house activities co-ordinator. There is a well landscaped garden for resident's use.*

*Qualified Nurses lead a team of Carers in offering highly skilled nursing care, under the supervision of the Manager. Prior to admission a full assessment of needs is carried out in consultation with relatives and carers, and a care plan developed, monitored and reviewed on a regular basis.*

*A Physiotherapist visits the Home each week and works with the residents to ensure mobility, wherever possible. We also have regular visits from a Chiropodist and a Hairdresser. Religious services are regularly held by visiting representatives off all denominations.*

*Our Chefs endeavour to offer homely cuisine using locally sourced produce, and see all residents daily to ensure that individual needs are catered for, and a variety of food is available. As well as three hot meals a day; alternatives, fruits, refreshments and snacks are available as required.*

*Residents are free to keep their own General Practitioner, so long as they agree and are able to visit the Home when necessary. We work with local medical practices who are willing to look after those residents whose doctor is unable to visit them.*

*Our fees are very competitive and based on the care needs and the accommodation selected for the resident. Fees include full nursing care, meals physiotherapy, laundry. Current fees will be advised at the time of your visit depending on the available room.*
